"Where are the birds?" is a common question this time of year. Fall harvest foods are available and you can bet your birds are taking advantage of them. These foods include insects, seeds, nuts. berries and fruits.

Birds are still using your feeders to supplement meals even though it is intermittent or seems non-existent. However, birds are also looking for and reviewing food locations for later winter use.

They often show a strong loyalty to feeders with high quality foods in sheltered locations and abandon feeders located in exposed areas like a yard with little-to-no cover.

THE WBU OUTFITTER Now Available For A Limited Time



The Outfitter is an exclusive WBU feeder, designed and patented by Jim Carpenter, Founder, President, & CEO of Wild Birds Unlimited.

The Outfitter features three feeding levels built into the core feeder which allows it to slide over a wooden post or be pole mounted.

1. The center feeding area features a 3-sided perch that allows birds to feed comfortably from the seed supply. The central seed chamber holds about 1.5 quarts of any type of seed. Just take off the lid to fill it.

2. The lid covering the central seed chamber doubles as a platform feeder and is especially attractive to birds just finding the feeder.

3. The wooden ledge over the center feeding area protects the seed from rain, but also doubles as a place to put seed, peanuts or other food like suet chunks and fruit.

By adding our optional side arm hardware (several options available) to the core feeder, you can customize your Outfitter with a variety of feeders to attract different types of birds.

Suet cages or side dishes can also be attached directly to the Outfitter. A catch a seed tray under the Outfitter can also be added.

The Outfitter is designed to be mounted on a 3.5" x 3.5" cedar or treated wood post or on our WBU Advanced Pole System.

Squirrel or Raccoon baffles are also available for either mounting option.

Originally introduced in 1998, the Outfitter was discontinued a few years later, reintroduced for a limited time in 2006, and now back.

We have had our original Outfitter in our front yard since 1999. We love it and so do our birds!

• Chickadees, titmice and cardinals will group with others of their species to form small winter flocks. • Kinglets, Hermit Thrushes, Yellow-rumped Warblers, American Robins, Fox & White-throated Sparrows. Red-winged Blackbirds and grackles leave the area. • Beavers are very active in the evenings while caching a winter supply of food.

• Frogs and toads settle into pond mud to over-winter/hibernate.

• Open water is important if there's an early freeze. Put out heated bird baths for a winter water source. • Tundra Swan Watch, Winona, MN. They reach a peak population of 2,000-6000 from mid to late November in Mississippi River Pools 7 & 8.
